NOW COMES the Plaintiff, CHRISTINA WHITE, by and through her attorneys, POWER ROGERS & SMITH, P.C., complaining of defendant, EDDY CURRY, pleading hypothetically and in the alternative, states:

1. That Eddy Curry (hereinafter "Curry") and Christina White (hereinafter "White") entered into a contractual agreement effective May 14, 2007 wherein Curry was to make various payments to White in settlement of a cause of action pending against him. (See Exhibit A).

2. The above-mentioned agreement required Curry to make specific payments at specific times to White.

3. That Curry was also required to pay pursuant to the agreement \$330,000.00 plus 7.5% per annum on July 3, 2008.


4. That Curry failed to make any payment as required by the Agreement on July 3, 2008.

5. That on December 1, 2008, Curry paid \$150,000.00 of the above amount.

6. To date Curry has failed to pay the remaining \$180,000.00 of the \$330,000.00 plus 7.5% per annum which was required to be paid on July 3, 2008

7. Pursuant to the above-mentioned Exhibit A, Curry "...agrees to the entry of judgment and confesses judgment against him in the amount of any unpaid payments plus attorneys' fees, expenses and interest pursuant to this Agreement and waives any defenses he may have to entry of judgment for any unpaid amounts as required by this Agreement." See paragraph 11 of Exhibit A.

WHEREFORE, the Plaintiff respectfully requests that this Court enter judgment in her favor and against defendant EDDY CURRY, for an amount in excess of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), which shall represent fair and just compensation.
