

understand, and walks into the store anyway. The owner then runs out the door and is able to escape. Tyson then appears with the gun and points it at Melinda. A second Victim, Robert ~~Robert~~ then enters the store. Melinda warns him and he sees the armed suspect. Robert exits the store and runs along the north side of the store. Tyson then fires a shot with a 40 caliber handgun, striking Melinda in the back of the head killing her. Tyson then exits the store and shoots Robert as he is trying to escape, hitting him in the right hip. Tyson then walked back toward the store. Robert was able to hide behind some bushes, concealing him from Tyson's view. Tyson came back out and looked for Robert but did not see him and went back to the store. A third Victim, Kenneth Matlock entered the store and was shot in the head killing him. During the robbery Tyson took about \$300 from the register, and a Taurus 40 caliber handgun from the store owner Brent Brown. Tyson also attempted to take Brent's vehicle. Tyson did take Kenneth's 2004 Dodge Dakota pickup truck after he killed him, and it appears that he may have taken cash from Kenneth's wallet as well. Detectives learned that Tyson dumped the stolen Dodge truck in a Walgreen's parking lot at 27th Avenue and Glendale. Tyson purchased a Greyhound Bus ticket for Long Beach from a 7-11, and then caught a bus for California. Tyson is on video at each of these stops. Detectives learned that Tyson's step-father's Taurus 40 caliber handgun is now missing from his truck, and he fears that Tyson may have taken it. Tyson's parents have reported him as a runaway juvenile to the Phoenix Police Department. Detectives also received a call from a male subject who stated that he met Tyson in the Walgreen's parking lot and Tyson asked him for a cigarette. He stated that Tyson was acting very nervous and when he asked Tyson why, he told him that some guy tried to car jack him so Tyson had to smoke him. His ride then came and Tyson was last seen waiting for the bus. A photo line up was shown with ~~Robert~~, and he positively identified Tyson as the shooter.

On 01-17-12 at approximately 1315 hours, Tyson Langley entered the Euphorium Emporium, a Smoke Shop located at 10140 W. Lake Pleasant Parkway, armed with a 40 caliber handgun. Tyson pointed the gun at the store owner and demanded money. While in the in the process of robbing the business, Melinda Bowen enters the store. The store owner then tries to warn her about the armed suspect, but Melinda did not
