FINAL JUDGMENT

On the 2nd day of October, 2012, came on to be heard the above entitled and numbered cause, and Plaintiffs Rebecca Budd and John Budd appeared in person and by attorney of record and announced ready for trial, and Defendants Adoption Access, Inc. and Deborah Hug, appeared in person and by attorney of record and announced ready for trial. A jury consisting of twelve (12) good and lawful jurors was duly impaneled and the case proceeded to trial.

At the conclusion of the evidence, the Court submitted the case to the jury on questions on Plaintiffs' claims of breach of contract; fraudulent inducement; fraudulent misrepresentation; fraud by omission; negligent misrepresentation; negligence and alleged violations of the Texas Deceptive Trade Practices Act. The Charge of the Court, including the questions and the verdict of the jury, are incorporated herein for all purposes by reference. It appearing to the Court that the verdict of the jury was for Plaintiffs and against Defendants Adoption Access, Inc. and Deborah Hug, judgment should be rendered upon the verdict in favor of Plaintiffs, and against Defendant Adoption Access, Inc.

The jury's findings, which are adopted by the Court, included that:

- Adoption Access, Inc. breached the Adoption Contract;

- Adoption Access, Inc. and Deborah Hug fraudulently induced Plaintiffs to enter into the Adoption Contract;
- Adoption Access, Inc. and Deborah Hug committed fraud against Plaintiffs;
- Adoption Access, Inc. and Deborah Hug made negligent misrepresentations on which Plaintiffs justifiably relied;
- Adoption Access, Inc. engaged in false, misleading or deceptive acts or practices that Plaintiffs relied on to their detriment that was a producing cause of damages to Plaintiffs, and such conduct was committed knowingly and intentionally;
- Adoption Access, Inc. engaged in an unconscionable action or course of action that was a producing cause of damages to Plaintiffs, and such conduct was committed knowingly and intentionally; and
- Adoption Access, Inc. was negligent.

The jury further found that the sum of money that would compensate Plaintiffs for their damages from Defendant Adoption Access' conduct is as follows:

- Adoption Fees - \$33,400.00;
- Past expenses for care and treatment of M.A. - \$23,058.44;
- Future expenses for care and treatment of M.A. - \$897,615.00;
- Mental anguish in the past - \$100,000.00;
- Mental anguish in the future - \$50,000.00;
- Additional damages because Adoption Access, Inc.'s conduct was committed knowingly - \$100,000.00; and
- Additional damages because Adoption Access, Inc.'s conduct was committed intentionally - \$100,000.00.

Plaintiffs Rebecca Budd and John Budd made an election of remedies under the Texas Deceptive Trade Practices Act with damages totaling \$1,370,673.40.

It is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED, that Plaintiffs Rebecca Budd and John Budd shall have Final Judgment against and shall recover of and from Adoption Access, Inc. the sum of \$1,370,673.40. This total sum shall bear post-judgment interest at 5% per annum, compounded annually from the date of entry of this Final Judgment until the Final Judgment is satisfied.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Plaintiffs Rebecca Budd and John Budd shall also have Final Judgment against Defendant Adoption Access, Inc. for their attorneys' fees of \$550,085.62, with conditional fees of \$75,000, if the matter is appealed to the Dallas Court of Appeals, an additional \$15,000 through the petition for review stage at the Texas Supreme Court, and an additional \$25,000 through an appeal to the Texas Supreme Court. This total sum shall bear interest at 5% per annum, compounding annually from the date of entry of this Final Judgment until the Final Judgment is satisfied.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that all costs of court expended or incurred in this cause are hereby adjudged against Defendant Adoption Access, Inc.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Plaintiffs Rebecca Budd and John Budd take nothing against Defendant Deborah Hug.

Plaintiffs Rebecca Budd and John Budd shall have all writs and processes that are necessary in the enforcement and collection of this Final Judgment.


It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that all other relief not expressly granted herein is denied.


