I have reviewed the affidavit of Justice Ann Walsh Bradley requesting the entry of a preliminary injunction as well as the motion of Attorney Kevin St. John opposing such an injunction. I believe, after reviewing these documents and internal correspondence, that the situation existing at the Wisconsin Supreme Court is one of uncertainty and turmoil.

If there is to be a transition of Chief Justice from Justice Shirley S. Abrahamson to Justice Patience D. Roggensack, there is a need for a transitional plan. I know that you are well aware of your authority to act based on your equitable powers. I respectfully request that you exercise such powers to set forth such a transitional plan, in order to address the chaotic situation that exists.
